ORDINANCE NO. 2003-07-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING § 50.10 OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY REVISING THE TRANSFER STATION USE FEE TO OFFSET THE “KENTUCKY HOUSE BILL 174 LANDFILL FEE.”

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue provides a solid waste transfer station facility for the benefit of residents and businesses located within the city; and

WHEREAS, the Kentucky General Assembly approved House Bill 174 which imposes a landfill fee on all generators of solid waste; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue has determined it is in the best interest of the citizens of Bellevue to increase the fee for the use of the solid waste transfer station facility to offset the “Kentucky House Bill 174 Landfill Fee” imposed by the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, KENTUCKY, THAT

SECTION 1

§ 50.10 of the City of Bellevue Code of Ordinances shall be amended as follows:

(A) Residents, property owners – occasional users. Persons who reside in a dwelling in Bellevue or who own residential property in Bellevue who utilize the transfer station less than six (6) times per calendar year may use the transfer station facility upon first obtaining a permit from the City Clerk and paying a flat rate of ~~twenty dollars (\$20.00)~~ twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each pick-up truck load not to exceed exceeding 2 ½ cubic yards or fifty dollars (\$50.00) for other trucks or trailers exceeding 2 ½ cubic yards but less than 6 cubic yards provided that they have a current city motor vehicle sticker or license show current documentation which demonstrates residency or property ownership within the City of Bellevue.

(B) Business – occasional users. Businesses located in Bellevue who utilize the transfer station less than six (6) times per calendar year or out-of-city businesses may use the transfer station facility upon first obtaining a permit from the City Clerk and paying a minimum rate of ~~forty dollars (\$40.00)~~ twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each pick-up truck load not exceeding 2 ½ cubic yards or fifty dollars (\$50.00) per load up to exceeding 2 ½ cubic yards but less than 6 cubic yards. Out-of-city businesses must be licensed in the city and can only deposit waste generated from business done in the city.

(C) Residents and businesses – regular users who utilize the transfer station less than six (6) times per calendar year. Those city residents, whether individual or corporate, business or household, requiring regular use of the transfer station facility not falling in the occasional category shall negotiate a contract with the city at a minimum rate of ~~forty dollars (\$40.00)~~ fifty dollars (\$50.00) per 2 ½ cubic yards or portion thereof. Contracts may be based on volume estimated for a period of one (1) year or less.

SECTION 2

This ordinance shall become effective upon passage, approval and publication according to law.
