ORDINANCE NO. 2003-11-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING § 50.10 OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY CLARIFYING AND CORRECTING THE LANGUAGE THEREIN.

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue provides a solid waste transfer station facility for the benefit of residents and businesses located within the city; and

WHEREAS, the existing language of the ordinance pertaining to the use of the transfer station needs clarified and corrected to reflect the original intent of the ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, KENTUCKY, THAT

SECTION 1

§ 50.10 of the City of Bellevue Code of Ordinances shall be amended as follows:

(C) Residents, property owners and businesses – regular users. Persons who live in, own property in or operate businesses in the City of Bellevue who utilize the transfer station less more than six (6) times per calendar year shall be classified as regular users. ~~Those city residents, whether individual or corporate, business or household, requiring regular use of the transfer station facility not falling in the occasional category shall negotiate a contract with the city at Regular users shall pay a minimum rate of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per 2 ½ cubic yards or portion thereof. Contracts may be based on volume estimated for a period of one (1) year or less.~~

SECTION 2

This ordinance shall become effective upon passage, approval and publication according to law.
