ORDINANCE NO. 2004-08-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 72 OF THE BELLEVUE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY CREATING AN APPEAL PROCESS FOR APPLICANTS DENIED A DISABLED ON-STREET PARKING SPACE BY THE CITY ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER.

WHEREAS, Chapter 72 of the City of Bellevue Code of Ordinances permits the establishment of disabled on-street parking spaces for persons meeting certain criteria; and

WHEREAS, the Bellevue city council desires to establish a procedure for allowing an appeal of a decision to deny an applicant an on-street parking space.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, KENTUCKY, THAT:

SECTION I

Chapter 72.66 is hereby amended to include section (E) as follows:

(E) The mayor shall appoint a hearing officer who will have the power to conduct hearings relating to grievances concerning the issuance or denial of on-street disabled parking permits. The decision of the hearing officer shall be final. Any appeal from the hearing officer's decision shall be made to a court of competent jurisdiction.
