ORDINANCE NO. 2004-09-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, CAMPBELL COUTNY, KENTUCKY, CHANGING THE NAME OF THE 700 BLOCK OF EDEN AVENUE BETWEEN VAN VOAST AVENUE AND THE CORPORATION LINE WITH THE CITY OF DAYTON TO "FRANK BENKE WAY" AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue changed the name of a portion Eden Avenue between Washington Avenue and Van Voast Avenue to "Frank Benke Way" by adopting ordinance 2001-03-05; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the unimproved section of Eden Avenue between Van Voast Avenue and the corporation line with the City of Dayton, more commonly known as the 700 block of Eden Avenue, was not included in the name change; and

WHEREAS, Cincinnati Bell has requested that this section of street be renamed to better facilitate emergency responses via the 911 system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Bellevue, Kentucky, as follows:

Section 1

That upon the effective date of this ordinance the 700 block of Eden Avenue between Van Voast Avenue and the corporation line with the City of Dayton shall be re-named "Frank Benke Way."

Section 2

All ordinances that are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
