

ORDINANCE 2004-10-01

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION STANDARDS FOR THE CITY OF BELLEVUE AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Kentucky Flood Insurance Rate Maps have been updated; and

WHEREAS, the Kentucky Environmental and Public Protection Cabinet Office of Legal Services, Water Legal Branch, has determined that the “Automatic Adoption Clause” in Bellevue’s current flood damage prevention ordinance does not conform to current state statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Kentucky’s National Flood Insurance Program Coordinators have developed a new and more comprehensive state model Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance for adoption and implementation in Bellevue; and

WHEREAS, the city council of the City of Bellevue has determined that the adoption of the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance attached hereto would bring the city into compliance with state statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the city council of the City of Bellevue that the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance attached hereto is hereby adopted in its entirety.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the city council of the City of Bellevue Section 9.25 of the Bellevue Zoning Regulations entitled “Flood Protection Development Controls” shall be and is hereby repealed in its entirety.

This ordinance shall become effective upon its approval, adoption and publication according to law.
