ORDINANCE NO. 2005-11-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE AMENDING CITY ORDINANCE 86-7-1, AMENDED BY ORDINANCE 2001-01-01, RELATING TO 911 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SERVICE, AND INCREASING THE MAXIMUM FEE TO FUND 911 EMERGENCY SERVICE FROM NOT MORE THAN \$3.00 PER ACCESS LINE PER MONTH TO NOT MORE THAN \$3.30 PER ACCESS LINE PER MONTH.

WHEREAS, the Campbell County Fiscal Court has voted to increase the 911 access telephone line fee from \$2.00 to \$3.30; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue currently allows for a maximum 911 access telephone line fee of \$3.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the city council of the City of Bellevue, Kentucky, that Ordinance 86-7-1, amended by Ordinance 2001-01-01, be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION I

...the City of Bellevue authorizes the establishment of 911 Emergency Telephone Service within its city with, with a maximum fee not to exceed Fifty Five (\$.55) Cents per access line per month for the first eighteen (18) months of installation; a maximum fee not to exceed Three (\$3.00) Dollars Three Dollars and Thirty Cents (\$3.30) per access line per month for the initial charge thereafter, with neither charge to exceed the total cost of twenty five (25) access lines per month on each monthly telephone bill,...

SECTION II

All other provisions of the above mentioned ordinance shall remain unchanged.

SECTION III

The provisions of this ordinance are severable, and the validity of any provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provisions thereof; and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect so long as they remain valid in the absence of those provisions determined to be invalid.

SECTION IV

This ordinance shall become effective upon passage, approval and publication according to law.
