ORDINANCE 2006-04-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, SECTION 110.02(A) OF THE BELLEVUE CODE OF ORDINANCE REQUIRING A LICENSE FEE FOR THE PRIVILEGE OF ENGAGING IN TRADE, OCCUPATION OR PROFESSION IN THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, BY INCREASING THE LICENSE FEE TO 2.50%.

WHEREAS, Title XI, Section 110.02(A) of the Bellevue Code of Ordinances establishes a license fee for the privilege of engaging in trade, occupation or profession in the City of Bellevue; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bellevue has determined that adjusting the established license fee to 2.50% will aid in the provision of necessary city services to the citizens of Bellevue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Council of the City of Bellevue, Campbell County, Kentucky, that:

SECTION 1

That Title XI, Section 110.02(A) of the Bellevue Code of Ordinances shall be amended to read as follows:

“It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in or follow any trade, occupation, or profession within the city, without paying a license fee for the privilege of engaging in or following that trade, occupation, or profession, which license fee shall be measured by ~~one and three quarters percent (1.75%)~~ two and one-half percent (2.50%) of the gross receipts of each such person.”

SECTION 2

That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3

That this ordinance shall become effective on July 1, 2006, after its adoption and publication according to law.
