

ORDINANCE 2006-05-05

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON PORTIONS OF FAIRFIELD AVENUE (KY ROUTE 8) FOR THE CONVENIENCE AND SAFETY OF CITIZENS.

WHEREAS, on or about April 14, 2004, the City of Bellevue City Council amended Chapter 77 of the Bellevue Code of Ordinances pertaining to locations for two hour parking; and

WHEREAS, two-hour parking was intended to be restricted to the curb lane in front of businesses; and

WHEREAS, the Gerry Barone Co, 618 Fairfield Avenue, has requested that parking be restricted to two hours in front of his business located at 618 Fairfield Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT Chapter 77, Schedule II of the Bellevue Code of Ordinances be, and is hereby, amended to read as follows:

SCHEDULE II: TWO HOUR PARKING.

No operator of any vehicle shall stop or park such vehicle at any time between 9:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. on weekdays and 9:00 a.m. and 3 p.m. on Saturdays in excess of two hours at the following locations:

All other ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
