ORDINANCE NO. 2009 – 08 – 01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, AMENDING CHAPTER 50 – WASTE COLLECTION TO CREATE A SECTION FOR DEFINING SCRAPPING AND SETTING THE HOURS THAT SCRAPPING IS PROHIBITED.

WHEREAS, Chapter 50 of the City of Bellevue, Kentucky, Code of Bellevue Kentucky, Code of Ordinances establishes waste collection regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to limit the hours of operation for persons and businesses engaged in scrapping within the City to the same hours as those for garbage collection;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Campbell County, Kentucky, that:

Section 1

That Chapter 50 of the City of Bellevue, Kentucky, Code of Ordinances shall be amended as follows:

§ 50.01 DEFINITION

“BUSINESS.” Commercial or industrial enterprise using a building including an apartment building with two (2) or more attached units.

“CITY SERVICE.” Waste collection one time per week, additional pickup may be contracted by the customer with a qualified waste hauler.

“RESIDENTIAL/COMMERCIAL.” Units that produce residential quantities of refuse once per week, located within Corporate limits of the City of Bellevue.

“SCRAP.” Any waste, or any old, abandoned, or unwanted metal, wood, glass, block, brick, rubber, plastic, vinyl, slate, building material, roofing material, wrought iron, wiring, piping, copper tubing, aluminum, steel, or any other material that may be recycled or discarded, for any purpose other than for the immediate discarding of such item(s) as waste.

“SCRAPPING.” Collecting, gathering, or hauling of any waste, or any old, abandoned, or unwanted metal, wood, glass, block, brick, rubber, plastic, vinyl, slate,

building material, roofing material, wrought iron, wiring, piping, copper tubing, aluminum, steel, or any other material that may be recycled or discarded, for any purpose other than for the immediate discarding of such item(s) as waste.

§ 50.02 REGULATIONS AND ENFORCEMENT.

(A) Residents and certain businesses as provided herein shall utilize garbage collection services provided by the city.

(B) The regulation and enforcement of sanitation, disposal, containers and storage of rubbish or garbage shall be as provided in the BOCA Basic/National Existing Structures Code 1987, as may be amended, adopted by ordinance.

(C) Containers shall not be placed at the curb earlier than the night before collection and shall be removed promptly thereafter.

§ 50.08 HOURS OF FOR COLLECTION OF GARBAGE OR SCRAP.

(A) No business involved in garbage or refuse collection within the city shall permit its drivers or collectors to make pickups except between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.

(B) No driver or operator employed by a garbage or refuse collection business shall make collections except between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. in the City of Bellevue, Kentucky.

(C) No person or business engaged in scrapping within the city shall be permitted to collect scraps except between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, KENTUCKY DOES
HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 2

This Ordinance may be read and published in summary form and shall take effect immediately upon adoption and publication according to law.
