MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING MARCH 27, 2010

Board of Council met in caucus session on the above date at 9:00 a.m. with the following members answering roll call:

MEMBERS: Camm, Brun, Riehl, Olliges, and Ratterman. Mayor John D. Meyer presiding.

MOTION: By Ratterman seconded by Brun that Council Member Guidugli be excused. Motion carried.

FOR THE RECORD: City Administrator, Keith Spoelker requested Council input for the 2011 budget. Administrator Spoelker stated that revenues are predicted to be stable, an increase is expected in health insurance and CERS costs. Renaissance funding is anticipated to be reduced.

FOR THE RECORD: Council Member Guidugli requested in writing the following items for discussion:

Build in a cost of living increase to the salaries of Mayor and Council.

Charge an occupational license for garage rentals.

Request that Code Enforcement and Police log calls and complaints.

Track costs associated with rental program.

Smart Code for entire city.

Enforce laws in place such as out of state vehicle registrations.

Work with foreclosed and new property owners.

Rid City of drug dealers.

FOR THE RECORD: Council Member Ratterman suggested that people should contact the city if they are interested in buying vacant or foreclosed properties.

FOR THE RECORD: Council Member Brun requested consideration of the following:

Lincoln Road sidewalk between Van Voast and Ward.

Snodgrass Park dedication for Ward and Center pocket park.

Doggie bag dispensers for Fairfield Avenue.

FOR THE RECORD: Council Member Brun left the meeting at 9:40 a.m.

FOR THE RECORD: Council Member Camm requested that the Historic District signs be redone in the blue color scheme.

FOR THE RECORD: Administrator Keith Spoelker reported that there are drainage issues on Lincoln Road. KZF provided an estimate of \$15,000.00 for a study of Lincoln from Harrison to Ward Avenue.

FOR THE RECORD: Council Member Olliges suggested that engineering services be bid out.

FOR THE RECORD: Council Member Riehl requested consideration of the following:

What appears to be a natural spring which is leaking in the area of Grandview.

Storm catch basin at Grandview and Washington which is turned the wrong way.

Questioned the status of the proposed parking area in the 100 block of Taylor.

FOR THE RECORD: Council Member Ratterman requested City of Bellevue lettering for Council Chambers.

FOR THE RECORD: Council Member Olliges suggested a line item in the budget for vandalism and graffiti expense.
