

COUNCIL CHAMBER CITY OF BELLEVUE, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL DECEMBER 8, 2010

Board of Council met in regular session on the above date at 7:00 p.m. with the following members answering roll call:

MEMBERS: Camm, Brun, Riehl, Ratterman, Guidugli and Olliges. Mayor John D. Meyer presiding.

The meeting was opened with a prayer and pledge to the flag.

MOTION: By Camm seconded by Brun that the following claims are paid:

FOR THE RECORD: State Representative Dennis Keene presented to outgoing Council Member Steve Brun a citation for service and appreciation from the Commonwealth.

FOR THE RECORD: Mayor Meyer expressed appreciation to Representative Keene for everything he has done for the City of Bellevue during his term of Office with special appreciation for the Covert Run project which is near completion. Mayor Meyer and Council Member Camm again thanked Representative Keene for their citations from the Commonwealth which were previously presented.

FOR THE RECORD: Administrator Spoelker advised that Covert Run will be near completion by Monday and will be opened during morning and evening hours while finish work is being completed.

FOR THE RECORD: John Yung, Zoning Administrator provided a Form Based Code presentation. Text amendment has been approved by Planning and Zoning and will be presented to Council for consideration. Mr. Yung explained changes made to the Form Based Code by the subcommittee of Planning and Zoning.

MOTION: By Camm seconded by Brun to accept the recommendations from Planning and Zoning for a text amendment. Motion carried.

FOR THE RECORD: Assistant City Administrator Jody Robinson reported on the following:

Residents are encouraged to drop their Christmas trees off at the Public Services department between December 26 and January 7. Campbell County will pick up for recycling.

Saturday December 11<sup>th</sup> 4 – 8 pm will be Customer Appreciation Night on Fairfield along with the Bellevue Neighborhood Association Holiday tour of homes.

January Shop Bellevue theme will be “Pub Shop and Crawl”.

Terry Ratsche will conduct a leaded glass window workshop on January 15<sup>th</sup> beginning at 1 pm the location will be 234 Foote.

FOR THE RECORD: Chief Cole reported on the following:

On Friday December 10, Fairfield Avenue will be closed to all traffic at Foote from 9 AM through about 3:30 PM. The state is having a contractor remove a large section of roadway to repair dips then will repave. Traffic will be re-routed and this is expected to be a one-day project.

MOTION: By Brun seconded by Camm that Ordinance 2010-09-02 stating the City of Bellevue’s intention to annex to the City of Bellevue, unincorporated area of 1.3558 acres, more or less, lying adjacent and contiguous to the existing city limits of the City of Bellevue, Campbell County, Kentucky be read for a second time. Motion carried.

MOTION: By Camm seconded by Brun that Ordinance 2010-09-02 pass the second reading. VOTE: Yes 6 No 0. Motion carried. THE ORDINANCE BECAME LAW.

MOTION: By Brun seconded by Camm that Ordinance 2010-12-01 approving the proposed text amendment of the Official Zoning Ordinance be read for a first time. Motion carried.

MOTION: By Camm seconded by Brun that Ordinance 2010-12-01 pass the first reading with the following change: Section 9.27 F. Bellevue Fire Department is changed to Bellevue-Dayton Fire Department. VOTE: Yes 6 No 0. Motion carried.

MOTION: By Brun seconded by Camm that Order 2010-12-01 authorizing and directing Mayor to extend and renew an agreement with Graydon, Head, and Ritchey for legal services be adopted as read. Motion carried.

FOR THE RECORD: Council Member Guidugli requested that Mayor call a Special Meeting of Council in December for the purpose of second reading and adoption of Ordinance 2010-12-01.

MOTION: By Camm seconded by Brun that a Special Meeting of Council be held on December 22, 2010 at 7:00 PM for the purpose of a second reading on Ordinance 2010-12-01. Motion carried.

FOR THE RECORD: Mayor Meyer reported on the following:

Community Christmas Concert will be held on December 12 from 5 – 6 PM at First Baptist Church. Bellevue Neighborhood Association Crib scene dedication will immediately follow.

Administrative Offices will be closed December 23 and 24<sup>th</sup>.

FOR THE RECORD: Mayor Meyer expressed sincere appreciation to the following: current City Council and all previous Council Members he has worked with his wife of thirty-one years, Sharon their three children; Kevin, Casey and Lisa and all the employees both current and past.
