

COUNCIL CHAMBER CITY OF BELLEVUE, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF COUNCIL JUNE 20, 2012

Board of Council met in special session on the above date at 7:00 p.m. The following members answered roll call:

MEMBERS: Olliges, Guidugli, Wiethorn, Rich, Almoslechner and Ratterman. Mayor Edward Riehl presiding.

MOTION: By Wiethorn seconded by Ratterman that Ordinance 2012-06-02 Ordinance requiring all gasoline and diesel filling stations to receive prepayment for fuel purchases be read for a second time by summary. Motion carried.

MOTION: By Wiethorn seconded by Ratterman that Ordinance 2012-06-02 pass the second reading. FOR THE RECORD: Member Ratterman questioned if any of the gas stations have commented on this and was advised that two of the three are already pre-pay only one will be effected. Member Guidugli questioned when the Ordinance will be published and was advised they will be scheduled for publication on June 28. VOTE: Yes 6 No 0. Motion carried. THE ORDINANCE BECAME LAW.

MOTION: By Wiethorn seconded by Guidugli that Ordinance 2012-06-03 amending the annual budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012 by estimating revenues and appropriating funds for the operation of City Government be read for a second time. Motion carried

MOTION: By Wiethorn seconded by Ratterman that Ordinance 2012-06-03 pass the second reading: Yes 6 No 0. Motion carried. THE ORDINANCE BECAME LAW.

MOTION: By Guidugli seconded by Ratterman that Ordinance 2012-06-04 adopting the annual budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 by estimating revenues and appropriating funds for the operation of City Government be read for a second time. Motion carried.

MOTION: By Ratterman seconded by Almoslechner that Ordinance 2012-06-04 pass the second reading. VOTE: Yes 4 No 2 FOR THE RECORD THE DISSENTING VOTES WERE CAST BY MEMBERS WIETHORN AND OLLIGES. Motion carried. THE ORDINANCE BECAME LAW.

MOTION: By Wiethorn seconded by Ratterman that Ordinance 2012-06-05 levying and assessing ad valorem taxes for General Fund and Municipal purposes for the City of Bellevue, Campbell County, Kentucky, for fiscal year July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013, of all Motor Vehicles assessed within the City and setting the tax rate at .385 per \$100.00 valuation be read for a second time. Motion carried.

MOTION: By Rich seconded by Guidugli that Ordinance 2012-06-05 pass the second reading. VOTE: Yes 6 No 0. Motion carried. THE ORDINANCE BECAME LAW.

MOTION: By Guidugli seconded by Ratterman that Ordinance 2012-06-06 updating the annual classification and compensation plan of the City of Bellevue be read for a second time. Motion carried.

MOTION: By Ratterman seconded by Almoslechner that Ordinance 2012-06-06 pass the second reading. VOTE: Yes 6 No 0. Motion carried. THE ORDINANCE BECAME LAW.

MOTION: By Wiethorn seconded by Ratterman that Ordinance 2012-06-07 amending chapter 50 of the City of Bellevue, Kentucky, Code of Ordinances relating to waste collection, establishing regulations

and a service fee; and amending the following sections of ordinance 95-6-3 and amending ordinance 2007-10-1 be read for a second time. Motion carried.

MOTION: By Ratterman seconded by Guidugli that Ordinance 2012-06-07 pass the second reading. FOR THE RECORD: Member Wiethorn questioned the contract expiration and was advised there will be one more two year extension in 2014 – contract expires 2016. VOTE: Yes 6 No 0. Motion carried. THE ORDINANCE BECAME LAW.

MOTION: By Wiethorn seconded by Ratterman that Ordinance 2012-06-01 repealing, rescinding and replacing Chapter 152 of the City of Bellevue, Kentucky, Code of Ordinances relating to floodplain management with a new Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance be read for a first time by summary. Motion carried.

MOTION: By Wiethorn seconded by Almoslechner that Ordinance 2012-06-01 pass the first reading. VOTE: Yes 6 No 0. Motion carried.

MOTION: By Guidugli seconded by Ratterman to adjourn at 7:25 pm Motion carried.
