MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING JUNE 19, 2013

The Public Hearing for the use of Municipal Road Aid and LGEA Funds for the fiscal year 2014 for the City of Bellevue began at 6:55 pm

City Clerk read the legal notice advertising the Public Hearing.

FOR THE RECORD: Tom Wiethorn, 715 Lincoln Road addressed Council to request that the total appropriation be used for the reconstruction of Lincoln Road between Harrison and Ward Avenue. Mr. Wiethorn questioned when the City would know if the State is committing funds for Lincoln Road.

Venessa Groneck, 354 Van Voast requested that total MRA funds be used for the reconstruction of Lincoln Road.

Joe Groneck, 7 Harrison stated that on June 4 he was promised a temporary patch and gravel placed on the north side of Lincoln. Mr. Groneck was advised that this would be done on Thursday June 20.

Member Rich stated that speed signs are needed on Lincoln Road.

Eric Brown, 237 Lafayette questioned the use of speed bumps. Mr. Brown was advised that the City insurance carrier does not recommend speed bumps from a liability stand point. Mr. Brown stated that stop signs are being disregarded at Lafayette and Prospect as well as Lafayette and Division.


Member Helton questioned if the City could place stop signs on both sides of the street in these areas to increase visibility.
