MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING WEDNESDAY JUNE 19, 2013

A Public Hearing for the budget for fiscal year 2014 was held on June 19 at 7:10 p.m.

The City Clerk read the legal notice advertising the Public Hearing.

FOR THE RECORD: Tom Wiethorn, 715 Lincoln Road questioned the anticipated revenues for FY 14 and was advised \$4, 071,400.00. Mr. Wiethorn further questioned the expenses and was advised \$4,071,400.00. Mr. Wiethorn questioned the amount budgeted for Police and Fire, advised \$1,412,300.00 Fire \$773,000.00. Mr. Wiethorn was advised that per the current inter-local agreement increases cannot exceed 6%. The City of Bellevue will set aside an additional \$36,000.00 for Capital outlay for the Fire Department.

FOR THE RECORD: Venessa Groneck, 354 Van Voast questioned if the City would consider capping the amount of payroll tax on teachers pay.

There being no comments the Public Hearing adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
