

ORDINANCE 2014-02-01

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON PORTIONS OF FAIRFIELD AVENUE (KY ROUTE 8) FOR THE CONVENIENCE AND SAFETY OF CITIZENS.

WHEREAS, in 2004 the City of Bellevue City Council amended Chapter 77 of the Bellevue Code of Ordinances pertaining to locations for two hour parking; and

WHEREAS, two-hour parking was intended to be restricted to the curb lane in front of businesses; and

WHEREAS, the City periodically reviews the parking restrictions on Fairfield Avenue;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT Chapter 77, Schedule II of the Bellevue Code of Ordinances be, and is hereby, amended to read as follows:

SCHEDULE II: TWO HOUR PARKING.

No operator of any vehicle shall stop or park such vehicle at any time between 9:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. on weekdays and 9:00 a.m. and 3 p.m. on Saturdays in excess of two hours at the following locations:

North side of Fairfield Avenue
from 201-205
from ~~223-217~~ to 245
from 301 to 321
from 331 to 343
from 401 to ~~411~~ 421
at 501
from 509 to 519
from 601 to 619
from 701 to 715

South side of Fairfield Avenue
from 224 to 240
from 300 to 318
from ~~336~~ 334 to 340
from 400 to 420
at 500
at 618
from 700 to 712

All other ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage, approval and publication according to law.
