The Fellowship of Christian Athletes requests permission to run the Fairfield Avenue Mile, Saturday, March 21 beginning at 9:00 a.m. As in the past several years, we would like for the race to start on Riviera Drive in the vicinity of Frisch's, proceed north on Riviera Drive, east on Fairfield Avenue, and south on Van Voast, ending near the end of the block.

I would request again that 3 police cars help block traffic. The Bellevue Police have always been an invaluable asset in blocking the Avenue at both ends. I think that we will again need a police car at the start of the race on Riviera Drive to block traffic coming north from Newport onto Riviera. We will assume responsibility for blocking intersecting streets along the race course.

I would also request permission to use the Callahan Community Center after the race for the awards presentation which usually concludes by 10:30.

This would be the 19th annual race. This race is always a lot of fun, and I hope continues to be a positive event for our community.

Proceeds from the race will be used to help sponsor coaches and athletes to attend FCA summer camps. In the summer of 2014, 10 athletes from Bellevue attended a week-long FCA All-Sports Camp in Albion, Michigan. It was awesome.
