

COUNCIL CHAMBER CITY OF BELLEVUE, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF COUNCIL MARCH 18, 2015

Board of Council met in regular session on the above date at 6:30 p.m. The following members answered roll call:

MEMBERS: Guidugli, Salzman, Poynter, Tatum, Slater and Olliges. Mayor Edward Riehl presiding.

FOR THE RECORD: City Administrator Keith Spoelker stated the purpose of the meeting is to solicit ideas and priorities from Council for the 2016 budget process. Administrator Spoelker reminded Council of items of significance effecting the budget such as the Lincoln Road project. SD1 has agreed to participate in a cost sharing of the project with the State however an additional \$75,000.00 in City funds from the 2016 budget will need to be transferred to the Lincoln Road Fund. Harbor Greene Fund will need and additional \$100,000.00 transferred from General for Bond payments. Fire Department will be seeking additional funding from each City.

FOR THE RECORD: Council began discussions which included:

Revenue enhancements – Permits and Vacant Property Registrations.
Formation of a Community Development Corporation.
Taylor hill – resurfacing
Washington – 200 block resurfacing
Curbs – 100 block of Washington

FOR THE RECORD: Council began a lengthy discussion of Red Bike Program– fund raising efforts, impact on business and residential community and use of tax dollars to support. Council will consider after fund raising efforts have been exhausted.

FOR THE RECORD: Fund raising kick off for Red Bike Program will be held on March 27 from 4-5 at Mackey Advisors.

FOR THE RECORD: Further budget discussion items:

Employee benefit package – capping with items such as take home vehicle, tuition reimbursement and health insurance all addressed.
Water Fountain for Bellevue Beach Park and Swope Park.
More Police presence at Swope Park – cameras considered.
Additional financial assistance for youth sports.
Engineering needed for Donnermeyer Drive and Riviera to address Flood Plain issues – future development dependent on this issue.

FOR THE RECORD: Administrator Spoelker advised that a draft 2016 budget document will be available for Council in early May.

MOTION: By Guidugli seconded by Slater to adjourn at 7:48 pm. Motion carried.
