**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF BELLEVUE APPROVING THE
AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY OF BELLEVUE
HISTORIC PRESERVATION GUIDELINES
MANUAL AS RECOMMENDED BY THE
BELLEVUE HISTORIC PRESERVATION
COMMISSION.**

WHEREAS, the city council of the City of Bellevue desires to promote and carry out economic development efforts through the preservation of historic architecture and structures within the Taylor's Daughters and Fairfield Avenue historic districts; and

WHEREAS, the city council of the City of Bellevue acknowledge that an accurate and current historic preservation guidelines manual is an essential and necessary tool for the preservation of historic architecture and structures; and

WHEREAS, the city council of the City of Bellevue acknowledge that historic preservation guidelines should be amended from time to time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the city council of the City of Bellevue hereby approve the amendments to the City of Bellevue Historic Preservation Guidelines Manual as recommended by the Bellevue Historic Preservation Commission.
