**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF BELLEVUE APPROVING THE  
AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY OF BELLEVUE  
HISTORIC PRESERVATION GUIDELINES  
MANUAL AS RECOMMENDED BY THE  
BELLEVUE HISTORIC PRESERVATION  
COMMISSION.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Bellevue desires to recognize the lifetime of service that Thomas Wiethorn provided to the City of Bellevue and its community; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Bellevue recognizes that Mr. Wiethorn was instrumental in the development of the City's riverfront park, known as the Bellevue Beach Park; and

**WHEREAS**, Tom's effort to provide statuary, plantings, and community events in the Bellevue Beach Park has led the park to be recognized as one of the best parks in the region.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Bellevue hereby rename the Bellevue Beach Park to the Thomas Wiethorn Memorial Beach Park as a tribute Mr. Wiethorn's lifetime commitment to the community of Bellevue.
