ORDINANCE NO. 2015-08-01

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL TRAFFIC ON BERRY AVENUE APPROACHING ANSPAUGH AVENUE FROM THE SOUTH TO COME TO A COMPLETE STOP BEFORE PROCEEDING THROUGH SAID INTERSECTION AND AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF A STOP SIGN AND OTHER WARNINGS AT THAT INTERSECTION.

WHEREAS, That the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Kentucky finds and determines that the safety and general welfare of its residents and visitors require that all traffic on Berry Avenue approaching the intersection of Anspaugh Avenue from the south may proceed through said intersection only after having first brought their vehicle to a complete stop.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, KENTUCKY as follows:

Section 1. All traffic on Berry Avenue approaching the intersection of Berry Avenue and Anspaugh Avenue from the South may proceed through said intersection only after having first brought their vehicle to a complete stop.

Section 2. The City Administrator or his delegate shall post a stop sign and paint the right of way indicating that it is unlawful for traffic proceeding from the south on Berry to proceed through the intersection of Berry and Anspaugh avenues unless only after having first brought their vehicle to a complete stop

This Ordinance shall be signed by the Mayor, attested by the City Clerk, recorded, published and shall be in effect at the earliest time provided by law.

PASSED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Campbell County, Kentucky, assembled in regular session.
