

ORDINANCE 2016-11-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, KENTUCKY, RELATING TO SECTIONS OF THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND DIRECTING THAT THIS ORDINANCE BE PUBLISHED BY SUMMARY.

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue desires to enhance the general welfare of the city deems it necessary and appropriate to amend its existing ordinance pertaining to alcoholic beverages;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

1. License Period

Section 112.25 (A) of the City of Bellevue, Kentucky Code of Ordinances is hereby deleted in its entirety and is replaced with a new Section 112.25 (A) to read as follows:

(A) All alcohol licenses under this Section 112, except special temporary licenses, be valid for a period of no more than one year and shall begin and end on ~~December 1~~ the dates specified by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Administrative Regulations for the City of Bellevue. Any licenses issued after such date of any year (or issued in the year the date is changed) shall be assessed a fee which is based on the pro-rata portion of the license period period; however, the cost of any license shall not be less than one-half (1/2) the amount of the full fee for an annual license of that type. When any person applies for a new license authorized by KRS 241 to 244 and Chapter 112 he or she shall be charged, if the license is issued, the full fee for the respective license if six (6) months or more remain before the license is due to be renewed and one-half (1/2) the fee if less than six (6) months remain before the license is due to be renewed. No abatement of license fees shall be permitted to any person who held a license of the same kind for the same premises in the preceding license period and who was actually doing business under the license during the last month of the preceding license period.

(B) The renewal by the City of any license hereunder shall not be construed to waive or condone any violation that occurred prior to the renewal and shall not prevent subsequent proceedings against the licensee.

2. Miscellaneous.

A. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

B. This Ordinance is hereby ordered to be published by Summary.

C. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force ten (10) days from its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

If any provision of this Ordinance is found to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance and the same shall remain in full force and effect.
