A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT PURSUANT TO KRS 65.210 ET. SEQ. BETWEEN THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, COLD SPRING, DAYTON, FORT THOMAS, MELBOURNE, SILVER GROVE, WOODLAWN, SOUTHGATE, HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, AND CAMPBELL COUNTY FISCAL COURT FOR ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City desires to work jointly and cooperatively with multiple Cities and the Campbell County Fiscal Court for the purpose of animal control services; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, KRS 65.210 to 65.300, permits public agencies to enter into interlocal agreements for joint or cooperative action.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY:

Section 1

That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Cold Spring, Dayton, Fort Thomas, Melbourne, Silver Grove, Woodlawn, Southgate, Highland Heights, and Campbell County Fiscal Court for the purpose of animal control services.

Section 2

That this order/resolution shall take effect and be in full force when passed and recorded according to law.
