RESOLUTION 2017-04-01

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RE-APPOINTMENT OF MARCUS CAREY, DARRYL CUMMINS, ROBERT F. GREENE, ROBERT SANDERS, CAROLYN LAINHART, AND TOM QUIRK AND THE APPOINTMENT OF WESLEY WILLIAMS AS MEMBERS OF THE NORTHERN KENTUCKY REGIONAL ETHICS AUTHORITY ENFORCMENT COMMITTEE FOR A TWO-YEAR TERM, COMMENCING FEBRUARY 1, 2017 AND EXPIRING ON JANUARY 31, 2019.

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 94 – 11 - 2 (as amended) established a code of ethical conduct applicable to the officers and employees of City of Bellevue and its agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, The City of Bellevue entered into an inter-local agreement to join the Northern Kentucky Regional Ethics Authority (NKREA) to implement said CODE OF ETHICS; and

**WHEREAS**, Article III(A) of the Inter-local gives the NKREA Authority Board the authorization to select members of the NKREA Enforcement Committee subject to the approval of each member jurisdiction's relevant legislative body;

**WHEREAS**, at the NKREA's Annual Meeting held December 7, 2016 the Authority Board re-nominated Marcus Carey, Darryl Cummings, Robert F. Greene, Robert Sanders, Carolyn Lainhart, and Tom Quirk to each serve a two-year term on the NKREA Enforcement Committee ;

WHEREAS, NKREA Enforcement Committee Member Daniel Cripe resigned and Wesley Williams was appointed by the NKREA Authority Board to fill Daniel Cripe's term; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY:**

Section 1

That the appointment of Marcus Carey, Darryl Cummings, Robert F. Greene, Robert Sanders, Carolyn Lainhart, and Tom Quirk as members of the NKREA Enforcement Committee for a two-year term commencing on February 1, 2017 and expiring on January 31, 2019 is hereby approved.

That this resolution shall take effect and be in full force when passed and recorded according to law.
