ORDER NO. 2017-10-01

AN ORDER FINDING AND DECLARING THE FOLLOWING EQUIPMENT AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE SALE OF SAME.

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue Police Department owns a Glock 21 .45 ACP duty pistol, serial # ZTH906; and

WHEREAS, the pistol was assigned to Colonel Wayne Turner; and

WHEREAS, Colonel Turner will retire from the City of Bellevue Police Department effective October 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Kentucky Revised Statutes allow purchase of surplus handguns by Bellevue Police Officers at fair market value

WHEREAS, it is customary of the City of Bellevue to declare the service pistol surplus and offer to the City of Bellevue Police Officer upon retirement from City Service in exchange for the fair market value of the weapon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY OF BELLEVUE that Colonel Turner's service weapon as identified is hereby declared surplus property and offered to him in honor of his service to the City of Bellevue in exchange for the fair market value of the weapon.
