The Fairfield Avenue businesses want to modify Bellevue Blossoms and turn it into a small festival. Based on the success of the Fall Festival they want to host a Spring Festival and move it back to the Saturday of Mother's Day Weekend. Their hope is to hold the Spring Festival in the city parking lot located at Taylor and Union from 11 am to 5 pm on Saturday, May 12. It will have many of the same components as the Fall Festival including:

- Family friendly
- Live music
- Food booth with Bellevue restaurants under one tent with sample size portions
- Visiting craft and garden related vendors
- Darkness Brewing and possibly a winery and/or New Riff

Ideally they would like to have the connection directly to Fairfield Avenue and to achieve this, the closing of Taylor from Fairfield to Union, leaving Union open to traffic.



REQUEST ONE: Allow for the event and set up in the city parking lot at Union Street and Taylor Avenue on Saturday, May 12 with event hours of 11am to 5 pm.

REQUEST TWO: Allow the sale of microbrew; and possibly craft distilling and Kentucky wine.

REQUEST THREE: Allow the temporary closing of Taylor Avenue between Fairfield Avenue and Union Street.
