

COUNCIL CHAMBER CITY OF BELLEVUE, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY

MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 6, 2018

The Public Hearing on the proposed tax rate of .348 per hundred dollar valuation for real estate and .496 of each \$100.00 of assessed valuation on personal property for the fiscal year July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 for the City of Bellevue began at 7 p.m.

PRESENT: Mayor Ed Riehl

Council Members: Brun, Rich, Poynter, Guidugli and Slater.

The City Administrator read the legal notice advertising the Public Hearing.

FOR THE RECORD: Administrator Spoelker advised that the 2018-2019 budget is based upon City taking a 4% property tax increase in revenue.

FOR THE RECORD: Member Guidugli noted that the additional \$57,000.00 in revenue received from taking the 4% does not cover the additional expenses needed for CERS and Radio costs.

FOR THE RECORD: Member Slater asked when the deadline is for converting radio – date not determined as of yet.

FOR THE RECORD: Council Member Guidugli noted that Bellevue has the lowest tax rate of all the river cities.

There being no further comments the Public Hearing adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
