ORDINANCE NO. 2019-02-01

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1985-8-4 ENACTED AUGUST 28, 1985, AND ORDINANCE NO. 2005-04-01 ENACTED MAY 26, 2005, RELATING TO THE REGISTRATION, PHOTOGRAPHING, AND FINGERPRINTING OF EMPLOYEES OF ESTABLISHMENTS SELLING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1985-8-4 enacted August 28, 1985, and as amended by Ordinance No. 2005-04-01 enacted May 26, 2005, required the registration, photographing and fingerprinting of employees of establishments in Bellevue selling alcoholic beverages; and

WHEREAS, KRS 244.090 restricts certain individuals from employment in establishments selling alcoholic beverages by the drink because of age and criminal convictions for both felonies and misdemeanors; and

WHEREAS, state ABC law provides comprehensive regulations for the sale of alcoholic beverages in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue charged fees to pay for the cost of administering the registration program, and required business owners to provide information and application forms regarding their employees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Council desires to remove impediments to conducting business in the City of Bellevue, and streamline governmental operations; and

WHEREAS, City staff time devoted to administering the registration program can be used for other endeavors; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Council desires to repeal the registration ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the city council of the City of Bellevue:

Ordinance No. 1985-8-4 enacted August 28, 1985, as amended by Ordinance No. 2005-04-01 enacted May 26, 2005, and as codified in Sections 112.60 through 112.65 in the City of Bellevue Coded of Ordinances required the registration, photographing and fingerprinting of employees of establishments in Bellevue selling alcoholic beverages are hereby repealed in their entirety.

This ordinance shall be effective when read, passed and advertised according to law.
