ORDINANCE NO. 2019-04-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE IN CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, PROVIDING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO DETERMINE TRAFFIC AND PARKING SIGNAGE AND MARKINGS IN CONSULTATION WITH THE POLICE AND FIRE CHIEFS.

WHEREAS, City of Bellevue Code of Ordinances Sec. 72.04(F)(1) states the “city shall determine on what streets or portions thereof stopping or parking be restricted or prohibited”; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Council desires to identify the person responsible for determining traffic and parking signage and markings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, IN CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

City of Bellevue Code of Ordinance Sec. 72.71 is hereby created:

Section 1.0

§ 72.71 REGULATION OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC SIGNAGE AND MARKINGS.

The City Administrator or his or her designee, in consultation with the Police Chief and Fire Chief, as appropriate, is delegated the responsibility and authority to establish and regulate parking and traffic signage, and markings on public streets, public right-of-ways and publicly owned parking lots.

Sec. 1.1 Provisions Severable

The provisions of this ordinance are severable; and the invalidity of any provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provision thereof; and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of those provisions determined to be invalid.

Sec. 1.2 Publication

This ordinance shall be published in accordance with Kentucky law.
