MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF COUNCIL JANUARY 9, 2020

Board of Council met in special session on the above date at 7:15 p.m. The following members answered roll call:

FOR THE RECORD: City Attorney Dave Fessler read for a second time Ordinance 2020-01-01 emending Chapter 90 of the Bellevue Code of Ordinances to increase the number of dogs allowed in a household from two to three, and allowing more dogs in a household under certain circumstances; and, removing breed specific references from Chapter 90.97.

MOTION By Fisher seconded by Hogan that Ordinance 2020-01-01, pass the second reading. VOTE: Yes 6 No 0. Motion carried. THE ORDINANCE BECAME LAW.

FOR THE RECORD: City Attorney Dave Fessler read Ordinance 2020-01-02 for a second time changing the time when distilled spirits, wine and malt beverages may be sold at retail from 11 a.m. on Sundays to 9 a.m. on Sundays in the City of Bellevue.

MOTION By Salzman seconded by Guidugli that Ordinance 2020-01-02, pass the second reading. VOTE: Yes 6 No 0. Motion carried. THE ORDINANCE BECAME LAW.

MOTION By Guidugli seconded by Salzman to adjourn at 7:20 pm. Motion carried.
