A. Ordinance 2020-09-01

An Ordinance amending Ordinance 2015-05-01, establishing registration procedures and maintenance requirements for vacant residential, and commercial, property located in the City of Bellevue, Kentucky.

B. Ordinance 2020-09-03

An Ordinance of the City of Bellevue regulating the planning, placement, maintenance, and operation of cellular antenna towers and small cell towers, and granting to the City the power to establish non-exclusive franchises for the use of the public streets, alleys, rights of way, and other public grounds of the City for cellular antenna towers and small cell towers.
