The Bellevue Police Department is accepting applications for the position of certified police officer. Application deadline is January 15th, 2021.

Requirements:

- Kentucky POPS Certified Officer
- Possess a valid driver's license
- Pass an oral interview, polygraph exam, a medical exam, and drug screening
- Pass a background check and be fingerprinted

About the Police Department:

The Bellevue Police Department provides 24-hour police protection for the City of Bellevue, Kentucky, which is located in the northernmost portion of Campbell County. The department employs 11 full-time sworn officers, as well as a police clerk. Calls for service are dispatched to the officers from the Campbell County Consolidated Dispatch Center (CCCDC), which is located at 998 Monmouth Street, Newport, Kentucky. CCCDC dispatches all calls for police and fire service to all agencies and departments in Campbell County.

Each officer, regardless of rank, is responsible for routine patrol of the city and for responding to calls for service. Additionally, each officer remains responsible for performing other duties within his area of specialty. These other duties include criminal and crime scene investigations, fingerprinting, bicycle patrol, community-oriented issues, and certain administrative functions.

The Bellevue Police Department currently schedules officers ten hours a day four times a week with rotating off days. Scheduling the officers this way allows them to have three days off every week and then every fourth week they receive three four day weekends in a row.

About the City of Bellevue:

Bellevue, Kentucky, is a Home Rule class city and is situated in the northernmost portion of the Commonwealth of Kentucky. Incorporated on March 15, 1870, Bellevue is located on the banks of the Ohio River, across from Cincinnati, Ohio, in Campbell County. The most recent population was estimated to be about 5,955. Newport, Kentucky, is to the west; Dayton, Kentucky, is directly to the east; and Fort Thomas, Kentucky, touches on the southern border. We take enormous pride in our history and the historic charm of our quaint river city. The abundance of historic, unique architecture, as well as the many amenities Bellevue boasts makes us an ideal choice for relocation of individuals and families, as well as businesses.

Current Benefits include:

- Competitive pay ranging from \$21.35 to \$32.47 per hour, plus state incentive pay. Hourly rate is based on years of sworn law enforcement experience.
- 11 paid holidays per year; at a nine hour rate, one floating holiday paid at a an eight hour rate.
- 80 hours of vacation for 1-7 years of service, 120 hours of vacation for 8-13 years of service, and 160 hours of vacation for 14 or more years of service.
- Paid sick time accrued at 1.54 hours per week.
- \$700 yearly clothing allowance and \$180 cell phone reimbursement
- Take home fleet (within 25 miles of the city)
- \$30,000 life insurance policy for employee
- Health/Dental/Vision insurance is available to all employees at the below rates. Those who waive the city insurance can receive a 40% reimbursement of the city cost. \$309.73 for single, \$585.39 for employee and spouse, and \$892.02 for family. All employees receive \$400 a year in a flex spending account.
