

CITY OF BELLEVUE
ORDINANCE NO. 2020-11-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SEC. 35.76 OF THE BELLEVUE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROVIDE AN ALTERNATE MEMBER FOR THE THREE-MEMBER BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT WHEN A REGULAR MEMBER MAY NOT BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN A MEETING.

WHEREAS, there is presently not a provision for an alternate member of the three-member City of Bellevue Board of Adjustment (“BOA”); and

WHEREAS, there will be times when a member of the Board of Adjustment may not be able to participate in a meeting in a matter pending before the BOA because of illness, travel, conflict of interest or otherwise.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, IN CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1

Sec. 35.76 of the Bellevue Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

§ 35.76 – MEMBERSHIP

The Board of Adjustments shall consist of three (3) members, all of whom must be citizen members, to be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of City Council. Not more than two (2) of these members may be citizen members of the Planning Commission. ~~Four-year terms.~~ Each member of the Board of Adjustments shall serve a term of four years. The Mayor shall appoint, subject to the approval of the Board of Council, one (1) alternate member to serve on the Board of Adjustments when a regular member cannot serve due to illness, travel, a conflict of interest or otherwise. The alternate member shall meet all of the qualifications and shall be subject to all of the requirements that apply to regular members of the Board of Adjustments.

Section 2

The Ordinance shall be effective when read, passed and advertised according to law.
