

**CITY OF BELLEVUE
ORDINANCE NO. 2021-05-03**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FLOOD DAMAGE
PREVENTION ORDINANCE 2012-06-01.**

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue in Campbell County Kentucky had previously established a Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance within the City of Bellevue; and

WHEREAS, as it pertains to the Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) recently completed revision to the countywide Flood Insurance Study (FIS) report and Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) for Campbell County, Kentucky and Incorporated Areas, that the floodplain management ordinances reflect the new FIRM effective date of August 10, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, IN CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 -

ARTICLE 3. GENERAL PROVISIONS

SECTION B. BASIS FOR ESTABLISHING THE SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD AREAS

The areas of special flood hazard identified by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) in the Flood Insurance Study (FIS) for Campbell County, date August 10, 2021, with the accompanying Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMS), other supporting data and any subsequent amendments thereto, are hereby adopted by reference and declared to be a part of these regulations by Bellevue, and for those land areas acquired by Bellevue through annexation. This FIS and attendant mapping is the minimum area of applicability of this ordinance and may be supplemented by studies for other areas which allow implementation of this ordinance and which are recommended to the City Council by the Floodplain Administrator and are enacted by City Council pursuant to statutes governing land use management regulations. The FIS and/or FIRM are permanent records of Bellevue and are on file and available for review by the public during regular business hours at the City Clerk's Office at 616 Poplar Street, Bellevue, KY, 41073.

Section 2 – Conflicting Ordinances Repealed

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3 – Effective Date

The Ordinance shall be effective when read, passed and advertised according to law.
