ORDINANCE 2022-01-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BELLEVUE CODE OF ORDINANCE § 97.20 TITLED PLAYING GAMES ON STREETS.

* * * *

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue Board of Council desires to clarify the manner in which enforcement can occur when children and others are using public ways in the City for playing or engaging in other activities that may cause harm to themselves or others or property.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, KENTUCKY:

Section 1

That Ordinance No. 132.-58 codified as § 97.20 and any amendments thereto are amended as indicated herein.

§ 97.20 PLAYING GAMES ON STREETS.

- (A) No person shall play any games or engage in any type of playful activity upon any of the public streets, sidewalks, alleys or public way or public property in the city in a manner that that places them in probable harm to themselves and/or other persons or property.
- (B) Subject to the approval of the City, a street, sidewalk, alley or public way or public property may be closed for a temporary period for activities to occur there.
- (B) No person upon roller skates, or riding in or by means of any coaster or similar device, shall go upon any roadway other than the roadway of a play street, except while crossing a highway on a crosswalk.

Section 2

Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 3

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force when passed, published and recorded according to law.
