ORDINANCE 2022-09-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 112.95 OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, KENTUCKY CODE OF ORDINANCES TO CHANGE THE METHOD IN WHICH THE CITY ALCOHOL BEVERAGE CONTROL ADMINISTRATOR IS APPOINTED.

WHEREAS, Section 112.95 of the Bellevue Code of Ordinances provides the general standards the City follows in regards to establishing the City Alcohol Beverage Control Administrator; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Council wants to change the method in which the City Alcohol Beverage Control Administrator is appointed to allow flexibility in whom may hold the position; and

WHEREAS, the City's Administrative and Clerical staff recommends the amendment to Section 112.95 set forth herein.

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLEUVE, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

Section 112.95 of the Bellevue Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

§ 112.95 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL (ABC) ADMINISTRATOR.

- (A) There is hereby established the municipal office of City Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Administrator, who shall be <u>appointed by Mayor, subject to Board of Council approval.</u> the City Clerk Treasurer.
- (B) The ABC Administrator, before entering upon his duties as such, shall take the oath prescribed in Section 228 of the Constitution, and shall execute a bond with a good corporate surety in the penal sum of not less than \$1,000.
- (C) The functions of the ABC Administrator shall be the same as provided by Kentucky Revised Statutes.

SECTION 2.

Ordinance 85-8-4 is hereby amended in order to change the City of Bellevue's method in which the City Alcohol Beverage Control Administrator is appointed.

SECTION 4.

All Ordinances or parts of any Ordinances in conflict therewith, to the extent of such conflict, if any, are hereby repealed.
