MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING MAY 12, 2021

A Public Hearing for the fiscal year 2021- 2022 for the use of Municipal Road Aid Funds of the City of Bellevue began at 6:45 pm.

FOR THE RECORD: Administrator Warnock noted that the City anticipates receiving 117,000.00 in State Road Aid funds for FY 22 and further explained that the City does have the option to enter into an agreement for Emergency Road Aid funds in the future. State withholds 3% however City would be able to obtain additional emergency funds. City Engineer has developed a road inventory, prioritizing each street in Bellevue for purposes of repairs.
