

EXECUTIVE ORDER

**ORDER PROHIBITING ALL OPEN BURNING IN CAMPBELL COUNTY,
KENTUCKY**

WHEREAS, Campbell County is experiencing a period of drought like conditions resulting in dry vegetation; and

WHEREAS, the County Judge/Executive has determined based on advice from the Campbell County Office of Emergency Management, National Weather Service, the Kentucky Division of Forestry and the Fire Chiefs of Campbell County that a major fire hazard exists; and

WHEREAS, The Campbell County Code of Ordinances Sec. 92.01 authorizes the County Judge/Executive to enact a ban on open burning when he determines that a major fire hazard exist; and

WHEREAS; a ban on open burning would serve to protect the health, safety, welfare and property of the citizens of Campbell County.

NOW THEREFORE, I Steve Pendery, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Judge/Executive of the County of Campbell, Commonwealth of Kentucky, do hereby order as follows:

1. It is ordered that all outdoor burning is prohibited until such time as conditions exist that in the opinion of the Judge/Executive warrant that this order be rescinded.
2. The provisions of this Executive Order shall be enforced by all sworn peace officers with jurisdiction in Campbell County, Kentucky.
