**MOTION:** By Guidugli seconded by Almoslechner that Ordinance § 2003-11-01 regarding the use, restrictions, rules and costs for the use of the solid waste transfer station facility pass. VOTE: Yes 6 No 0. Motion carried. THE ORDINANCE BECAME LAW.

**FOR THE RECORD:** City Attorney Dave Fessler read Ordinance 2025-11-01 an ordinance amending the text of the official zoning ordinance for the City of Bellevue, Kentucky related to medical cannabis facilities.

Discussion was held and the decision was made to modify and send back to Planning & Zoning.

**MOTION:** By Guidugli seconded by Almoslechner that Order 2025-11-01 an order approving an agreement with SD1 to allow the placement of a stormwater overflow pumping station and approving an easement agreement. Motion carried.

**MOTION:** By Guidugli seconded by Ondeck that Order 2025-11-02 an order approving an agreement with Bellevue Independent School District to help pay for the construction of a stormwater retention system. Motion carried.

**MOTION:** By Guidugli second by Bothman to adjourn at 7:54 p.m. Motion carried.
